

Admitted changes in the final thesis cf. UvA Doctorate Regulations 2020

(compared to thesis manuscript)

- **Mandatory: Title page generated by the Office of the Beadle, which has been checked by the candidate (step 4) and approved by the dean's delegate (step 6);**
- Typographical errors in the manuscript. Only corrections to typographical errors are permitted.
All other changes and corrections (including correction of grammatical errors) are seen as substantive changes to the content and are expressly forbidden*;
- Colophon;
- ISBN number (optional);
- Layout and design, such as changes to page numbering, font and the location of tables and figures (however, it is not permitted to add *new* tables or figures);
- Cover;
- Propositions*;
- Curriculum Vitae (optional);
- Word of thanks (optional).

*) For substantive changes to the content the approval of the dean is **required**. Send e-mail to promotiezaken@amc.uva.nl

In case a publication is accepted after the submission of the manuscript to the Doctorate Committee and for screening on plagiarism, it may **not** be published in its final version in the definitive PhD thesis. Instead, add a reference to the article as published in the journal in the definitive version of the PhD thesis.
