

Dear APH-Quality of Care members,

We are pleased to inform you about three APH-QoC grants for which you can now apply.

- **Innovation grant:** to facilitate innovative research proposals within the APH Quality of Care research program. The focus is on 1) thematic deepening of research themes and profiling of our research program and 2) cross-pollination and exchange of ideas and expertise among researchers and research groups aligned with Quality of Care. One grant of €15.000 is available.
- **Secondary data analysis grant:** to support PhD students/junior researchers/ postdoc researchers in using research data to the fullest. The potential benefits of using secondary data include for example, economic savings, examining clinically significant research questions in large datasets that have been collected over time (longitudinal data), generating new hypotheses or clarifying research questions, and avoiding overburdening sensitive populations or investigating sensitive areas. One grant of €10.000 is available.
- **Travel grant:** to support PhD students and junior researchers in their personal development by organizing a working visit to a foreign research institute or university in the context of (doctoral) research. One grant of €2.500 is available.

Decision by Quality of Care Program Council	During the Spring Meeting April 22 nd , 2024
Time of visit/course	May 1 st 2024 (or later, but before end of 2024). If needed, the costs may be incurred in 2024 while the visit or course takes place in 2025
Report	Two months after returning from the visit/course
