The role of variability in motor learning

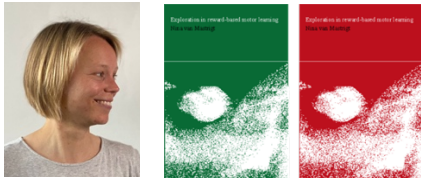
Wednesday December 6, 2023
