What is EndNote?

EndNote is a multiplatform software tool that helps to manage the process of writing and preparing research papers. It allows you to:

- Import citations from literature databases (such as Web of Science or PubMed)
- Organize references into groups
- Add full-text documents to your references
- Automatically insert well-formatted citations into Word
- Automatically reformat citation style in one click

EndNote is a good reference management tool that helps you to organize the publications you have seen and read. You can annotate your references, add the full text, search them and share easily. But, moreover it leads to accurate citations. It enables you to work more efficiently and effectively and saves time.

In this Lib-Guide you will learn how to get started, add references, organize your library and add references into your document.

- EndNote should be installed on your own computer or workstation. Contact the UCIT Servicedesk.

- 12 READ & Publish deals with all major *hybrid* publishers (Elsevier, Wiley, Springer, Sage, Taylor and Francis, Karger, BMJ, Walter de Gruyter etc)
- You can publish GOLD OA in >11.000 journals without costs; (Represents approx 70% of AUMC publishing)
- Publish in FULL GOLD OA publishers (PLOS, BMC, MDPI, Frontiers) or FULL OA journals (Wiley, SAGE), APCs paid by your department (Represents approx 10% of AUMC publishing)
- Green If all else fails: deposit your 'accepted manuscript'

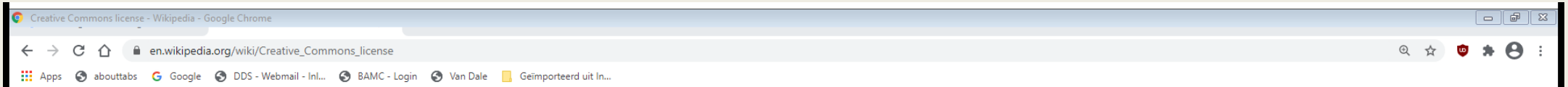

and "sa" clauses, which are mutually exclusive; and one includes none of the clauses. Of the eleven valid combinations, the five that lack the "by" clause have been retired because 98% of licensors requested attribution, though they do remain available for reference on the website.^{[31][32][33]} This leaves six regularly used licenses plus the CC0 [public domain](#) declaration:

The seven licenses in most frequent use are shown in the following table. Among them, those accepted by the Wikimedia Foundation – the public domain dedication and two attribution (BY and BY-SA) licenses – allow the sharing and remixing (creating derivative works), including for commercial use, so long as attribution is given.^{[33][34][35]}

The latest version 4.0 of the Creative Commons licenses, released on November 25, 2013, are generic licenses that are applicable to most jurisdictions and do not usually require ports.^{[36][37][38][39]} No new ports have been implemented in version 4.0 of the license.^[40] Version 4.0 discourages using ported versions and instead acts as a single global license.^[41]
