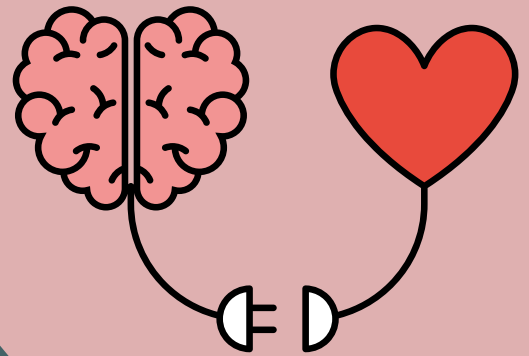


Symposium Friday October 23rd
